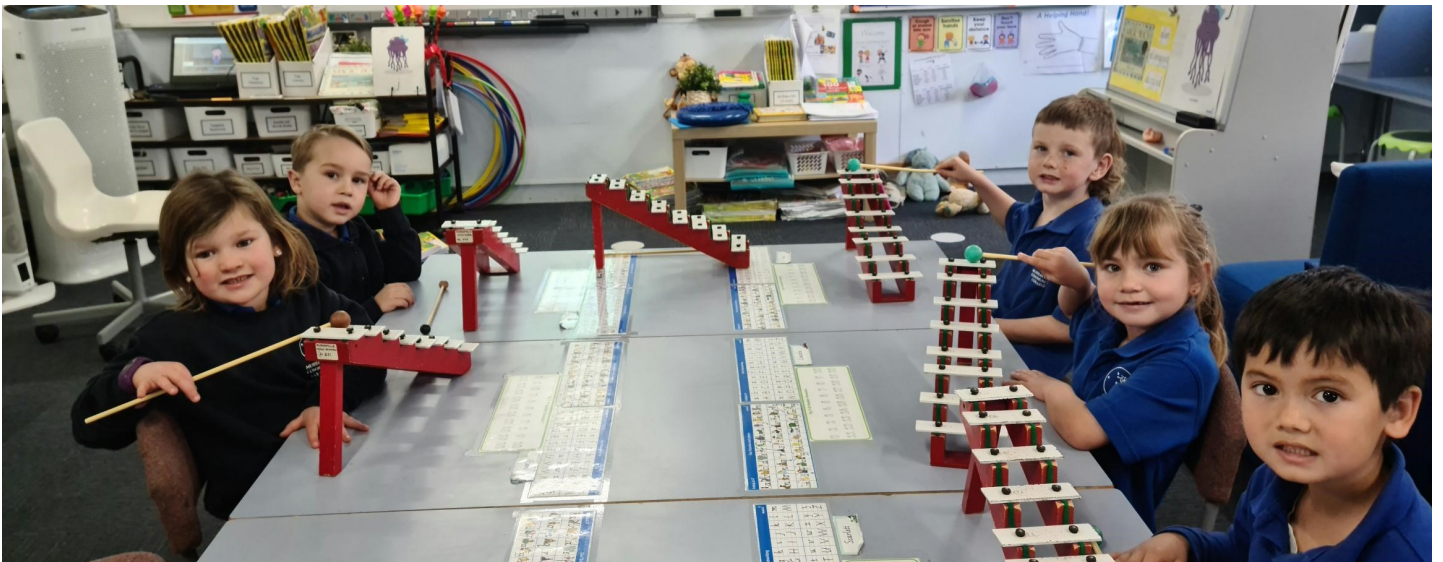
### **Long Service Leave –**

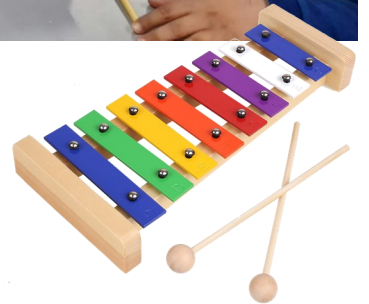

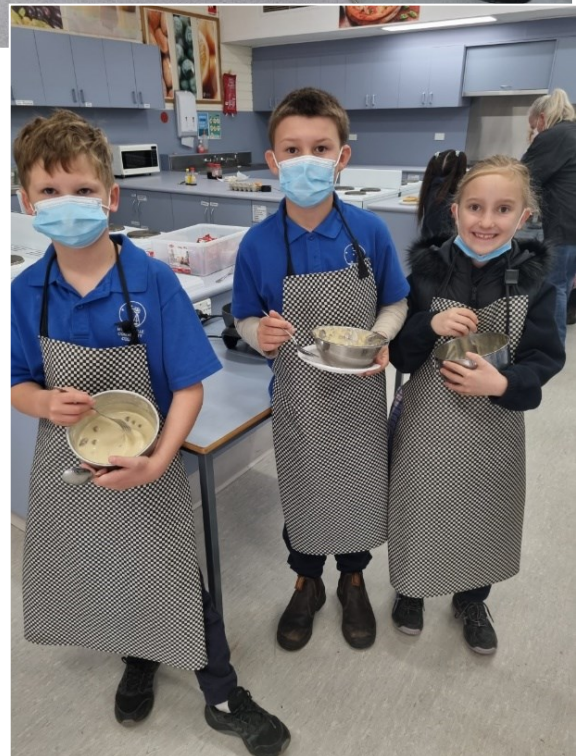
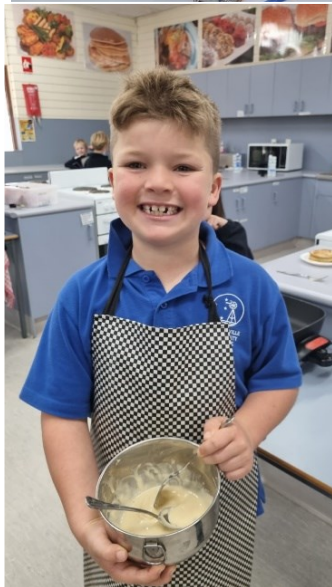
