### **Mallee Division Athletics –**

A smaller contingency of Secondary students also travelled to Ouyen this Wednesday to compete in our interschool athletics event. Unfortunately, a few of our students who had qualified weren't able to attend due to sickness. Those who competed on the day did very well, we had a number of firsts – which provides qualification for the North West Regional athletics event in Bendigo early next term. Congratulations to all of our competitors and thanks to Mr Watson and Mr Willison for their organisation of our team and with assisting on the day.

### **GAT –**

Next Wednesday our Year 11 and 12 students will be sitting the GAT (General Achievement Test). The GAT is changing in 2022 and is split into two sections. The first section assesses the students' skills in Literacy and Numeracy particularly, and the second section assesses their skills in the learning areas of maths, science, technology arts and humanities, with a focus on creative and critical thinking skills. Students are allowed 2hrs and 15mins to complete Section A and 1hr 45mins to complete Section B (including reading time). The GAT is used as a cross-reference to moderate Year 12 SAC and exam scores, so is an important part of the students' VCE.

### **Farm Safety Day –**

The Ouyen Farm Safety Education Day is held on a working farm at the Melbre property 9kms West of Ouyen. The event involves a series of interactive presentations relating to various aspects of safety, including vehicles, animals, machinery, workshops, chemicals and more. Students in Years 2-6 will be attending this event on the last Tuesday of term, September 13<sup>th</sup>.

### **Student Free Day –**

We are holding a whole school staff professional learning on **Wednesday the 14<sup>th</sup> of September**. An acclaimed presenter "Bronwyn Ryrie-Jones" is coming to deliver a professional learning around responsive teaching. This will build teachers' capacity to assess students' understanding within a lesson and adapt the way that they teach to ensure their teaching is meeting the needs of every student.
